UNIFORM PANTS

Boys and girls may wear navy **twill slacks** with tapered or straight legs. No stretchy or knit fabric pants that are tight, clingy and look like leggings are allowed.

Only uniform style shorts are allowed during the fall up to November 1 and the spring starting April 1. These are available through stores like Dennis, The Gap, Lands End etc.

Both boys and girls are expected to wear short or long sleeve button up polos daily. White shirts are to remain tucked in at all times except during recess. Undershirts are to be white only.



In lieu of slacks, girls in **K-5th** may wear a uniform jumper or skort. **Girls in 6-8th** may wear uniform skirts. Plain navy blue, black and white socks or tights are expected to be worn daily. **NO Leggings or jeggings pants** are allowed under these.





SWEATSHIRTS: As part of their daily uniform, students may wear our St. George Dragons sweatshirt **with their white polo.**

Sweatshirts will be on sale in August through our main office. Look for the link to come out in the newsletter.



We also sell golden St. George T-shirts that may be worn on First Friday Spirit Days, fieldtrips and PE for grades 5-8. **These are not for daily wear to school.**

Students are also welcome to continue to wear our blue button up sweater, a pullover sweatshirt or vest that are **ONLY** available at Dennis Uniform. Students **don't not need both** a sweatshirt and a sweater.



Socks All students are expected to wear plain white, black or blue socks or tights.

PE Uniform requirement options for Grades 5-8. PE is not free dress.



Students in Grades 5-8 may change into **long black or blue gym shorts** (NO SPANDEX) and any **St. George t-shirt** for PE class. NO tank tops. After PE, they are expected to change back into their uniform.

ALL students in Grades K-8 are expecting to bring an EXTRA pair of court non-marking sneakers for PE in our gym. NO black soles. They do not need to be fancy shoes. The shoes will remain at school through the year. Please write your child's name on the sole with a Sharpie as many look alike!

We ask parents to **label** all **sweaters, sweatshirts, coats,** lunch boxes and water bottles with their child's name so that we can easily return lost items. With 270+kids our Lost and Found bin erupts within two weeks!

RESUABLE water bottles and lunch boxes. We ask students to bring a personal water bottle to school daily.

First Fridays' Spirit Day. On the first Friday of every month, students are allowed to wear a pair of blue or black **jeans** and **any** St. George t-shirt or sweatshirt in lieu of their full school uniform. Their other choice is their school uniform

\$1.00 Pay to play. At times through the year, the student council will host a FREE DRESS fund-raising theme day in which students can pay \$1.00 to participate. For example, we may have a Blue Friday where students can pay \$1.00 to dress in Seahawks swag for student council funds, or student council may proclaim a *dress in pink* for breast cancer awareness. All proceeds will go to the honor the purpose of the theme day. Students are always required to honor **the modesty and Christian values of our uniform policy** in whatever clothes they choose to wear.
